Prayer in this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Amrik Singh in case FIR No. 77, dated 15.08.2014, for the offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

As per allegations, recovery of 3000 ml. of intoxicating material was made from the conscious possession of the petitioner/accused, which as per report of Chemical Examiner, tested as Codeine Phosphate, and, therefore, falls in commercial category.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.
