JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to provide security to him as well as to his family members, as they are receiving threats to their lives.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though some representations were made to various authorities including Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot and Deputy Commissioner, Gurdaspur but despite the fact that a period of approximately one month is going to expire no action has been taken.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4- Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated January 18, 2016 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
