Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.50, dated 11.03.2016, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala.

Vide order dated 11.04.2016, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail subject to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer and that she would join investigation as and when called upon.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required by the investigating agency as the investigating agency has found the petitioner to be innocent.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 11.04.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
