This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.176 dated 08.12.2014 registered under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the N.D.P.S. Act, at Police Station City-1, Abohar, District Fazilka.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Banta Singh has stated that only one witness remains to be examined

and the same will be examined on or before 27.10.2016 and till such time

bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Additional Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 27.10.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
