Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 15 dated 20.2.2016, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 12.4.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
