Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Kashmir Singh in case FIR No.109 dated 11.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code (Sections 307 & 308 IPC already deleted vide DDR No.17 dated 17.03.2016) registered with Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

As per the allegations leveled by the complainant-Gurmukh Singh, on 03.08.2015 at 10:30 PM, the present accused-Kashmir Singh accompanied by six other co-accused inflicted 12 injuries upon his person.

The role attributed to the present petitioner-Kashmir Singh is that he inflicted two Kirpan blows on the right arm of the injured-Gurmukh Singh.

It is contended that both the attributed injuries have been opined to be simple in nature. That apart, Gurmukh Singh has amicably settled the dispute with the accused party as per the compromise deed dated 04.01.2016 (**Annexure P-1**).

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated in the same.

Learned State counsel assisted by HC Balwinder Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and as such is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 12th of April, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
