In FIR No.17 dated 16.01.2015, under Sections 420, 411, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector-36, U.T, Chandigarh, petitioner was arrested on 08.12.2015.

The allegations are that the complainant was lured by the petitioner-Love Kumar for giving the ornaments for act of godly nature. The complainant easily believed the petitioner and parted with her ornaments. The case is triable by the Magistrate. In that view of the matter, trial will take along time. Undoubtedly, the complainant counsel pointed out several other cases of the similar nature against the petitioner.

Be that as it may, since the petitioner is under trial and the case is triable by the Magistrate, I am inclined to grant bail to the

petitioner.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence. Petitioner shall furnish an undertaking with the trial Court that he will not be indulged in such type of offences in future and in case, he is found indulging in such type of offence, liberty is reserved in favour of the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail.
