Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for protection of their life and liberty.

Learned counsel submits that petitioners No.1 & 2 are major and have married against the wishes of parents of petitioner No.1. They have placed on record Annexures P-1 & P-2, as proof of their age and also marriage certificate Annexure P-4. He further submits that a representation (Annexure P-6) was made to the Inspector General of Police, U.T. Chandigarh bringing to his notice that the petitioners No.1 & 2 have married and now the petitioners feared threat to their life and liberty from respondents No.6 to 14.

After hearing counsel for the parties, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into representation, Annexure P-6, preferred by petitioners and take appropriate steps, if circumstances so warrant. However, this court does not express any opinion with regard to validity or otherwise of the marriage.
