The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.91,
dated 23.4.2011, registered under Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, at
Police Station Aadampur, District Jalandhar.

As per the allegation in the FIR, deadly weapons like AK 47
rifle and one US carbine magazine stated to be belonging to the
petitioner have been recovered.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the only evidence

against the petitioner is the disclosure statement of the co-accused and that the petitioner has been in custody since 15.1.2015.

Learned DAG Punjab states that the petitioner is a hardcore criminal and is involved in many other cases but has admitted that there is no conviction against him as yet in any case.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
