JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

On instructions from ASI Satwinder Singh, learned State counsel has submitted that a complaint from the petitioner-Rani was received by S.H.O. Police Station City Nakodar on March 01, 2016 and subsequent thereto, another similar complaint was moved by her on March 10, 2016 to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Nakodar. Thereafter, instant representation/complaint was moved before this Court.

He has further submitted that S.H.O. Police Station City Nakodar is already seized of the matter. During the course of inquiry, notice was issued to petitioner to join the proceedings but she did not appear to make her statement. However, the statements of Lakshmi & Shindo have been recorded. Moreover, there appears nothing on record to suggest that an inquiry is not being conducted fairly or impartially by the officer(s) concerned.

Considering the aforesaid aspects, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to Station House Officer, Police Station City, Nakodar and Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Nakodar to conduct a fair and impartial inquiry into the allegations unfolded by the petitioner in her various representations referred to above and in case some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
