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JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioner and his family members and further to direct respondent No.2 to take action against private respondents who have allegedly grabbed the land belongs to petitioner's nephew.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though an application dated January 08, 2016 (Annexure P-1) was made to respondent No.2 but till date no action has been taken.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated January 08, 2016 (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
