Reply on behalf of the State/respondents No.1 to 4 by way of affidavit of Navneet Singh Mahal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Bholath, District Kapurthala has been filed. The same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala submits that the official respondents undertake that they would not interfere into the very factum of custody of the child in this tussle between the husband and wife.
