This is a petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by Lalchand-petitioner seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate legal action on the representation dated 08.05.2014 and 28.07.2014 (Annexures P-1 and P-2).

2. Notice to respondents No. 1 to 3, only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that representations dated 08.05.2014 and 28.07.2014 (Annexures P-1 and

P-2) were moved to Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra (Haryana) but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra (Haryana) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representations dated 08.05.2014 and 28.07.2014 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
