JASPAL SINGH, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Manjot Singh-petitioner, seeking permission to go abroad, in case, FIR No. 112, dated 30.04.2015, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 447, 511 and 120-B IPC.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sukhwinder Singh, Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar that challan is complete and is likely to be presented shortly in the court of Id. Jurisdictional Magistrate.

3. The instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the police to present the challan within a period of 15 days in the Court of Id.

Jurisdictional Magistrate and further the petitioner is directed to move an

appropriate application for permission to go abroad before the concerned Court, which shall be dealt with and disposed of within a period of 15 days.
