Report dated 04.05.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class Malerkotla has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Daljit Singh, Harpreet Kaur, Hardeep Kaur, Gurdeep Singh as well as of complainant Kirpal Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not heinous in nature and that this compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.37 dated 17.04.2014 under Sections 341, 323,506,509,201 34 IPC Police Station, Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur

and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
