By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.134, dated 30.12.2015, registered under Section 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

It is contended that the present FIR is a counter blast to the complaint filed by the petitioner on 03.08.2015 pending consideration before the SSP, Patiala. The petitioner is working as a peon in the University and he is in no position to facilitate the recruitment of the complainant in the University. He further states that the amount was never received by the petitioner. The alleged

pulsar motorcycle is registered in the name of son of the petitioner. Earlier also, the petitioner was framed in similar false FIR which stands compromised. In pursuance of the order dated 12.04.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, he is involved in another two FIRs. The recovery of Rs.2,46,000/- and one pulsar motorcycle is yet to be effected.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and has not misused the concession of bail, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.04.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
