Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to transfer the investigation to some independent agency or to constitute a special investigation team in case FIR No.21 dated 17.4.2015 under Sections 307, 148 and 149 IPC as well as Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Kabirpur, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to consider the representation dated 21.12.2015 (Annexure P-2) made by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.
