AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for the grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 120 dated 13.09.2015, under Sections 365, 394, 392, 323, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel has argued that as per the allegations the petitioner

and his friends forcibly put the complainant in a car, gave him beatings and

thereafter released him and at that time they were also armed with weapons. He has further argued that that was only simple injury and the petitioner has been in custody since 17.12.2015 and in the trial not even a single witness has been examined. Learned DAG has accepted these factual assertions.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the present petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
