KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioners claim that they are senior citizens. There is some matrimonial dispute between their daughter-in-law (respondent No. 4) and her husband, who is settled in Canada. It is stated that the petitioners are already appearing in the domestic violence case. However, respondent No. 4 is repeatedly filing the complaints before the police and they are being summoned to the police station time and again, resulting in harassment.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that if the petitioners are sought to be summoned in connection with complaints, compliance of Section 160 Cr.P.C. be made.
