TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.02 dated 20.04.2010, under Sections 307, 324, 326, 452, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Kashmir Singh. Occurrence is stated to be of 14.04.2010.

Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, he was alleged to be armed with a datar and having inflicted a blow with the same on the elbow of the left arm of Kuldeep Singh.

During the course of arguments today, it has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner chose to evade the process of law and was declared a proclaimed offender on 02.05.2011.

It is only on 07.02.2016 that the petitioner has been arrested and now brought to trial.

Under such circumstances, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner the benefit of bail.

Petition dismissed.
