By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.13, dated 24.02.2016, registered under Sections 307, 323, 341, 336, 148 read with Section 149 IPC, at Police Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar.

It is contended that in the alleged occurrence, three persons including the complainant Jasbir Singh are stated to have suffered injuries. Offence under Section 307 IPC has been cited on account of injuries suffered by Gurvinder Singh on his head which has been specifically attributed to co-accused Surjit Singh and who has since been arrested. He further submits that insofar as the present

petitioner is concerned, a baseball bat blow has been attributed on the left shoulder of Gurvinder Singh. In pursuance of the order dated 12.04.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.04.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
