JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Surender @ Kala in case FIR No.37 dated 22.02.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 325, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Civil Line, Kaithal, District Kaithal, Haryana.

As per the version of the complainant Kuldeep Singh while going on his Activa Scooter on 21.05.2016 at around 4.00 pm, he was waylaid by six accused including the present petitioner who came in Fortuner vehicle and inflicted injuries.

The petitioner-accused is attributed a *Gandasi* blow on the right

leg near the knee and another blow on the left shoulder of the complainant.

It is contended that both the parties are property dealers and have a civil dispute, therefore, there is a probability of false implication. He further contends that even the attributed injuries have been opined to be simple in nature.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated in the same.

Learned State counsel assisted by SI Rajvir Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and are longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 12th of April, 2016/11th of May, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
