The charge under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 460, 506/34 IPC has been framed against the petitioner by the trial Court. The trial is pending in the present case against the petitioner.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to release the petitioner on regular bail and the present petition is dismissed as such.
