This order will dispose of two applications for grant of bail, one (CRM-M-12864-2016) filed by Bhola Singh and others and the other (CRM-M-12947-2016) filed by Kashmir Singh.

The FIR was registered at the instance of complainant Baljit Singh alleging that on 05.11.2015 when complainant along with Lal Singh and seven other persons were going towards his fields for irrigation on

tractor of Lal Singh, they were attacked by the petitioners. Petitioner Bhola Singh has been attributed a 'gandasi' blow on the head of Lal Singh resulting in a grievous injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioners at this stage seeks permission to withdraw the petition on behalf of petitioner Bhola Singh.

So far as petitioners Gurnam Singh and Nishan Singh are concerned, they have been attributed injuries on the person of Lal Singh with 'gandasi' and 'daang'. Injuries attributed to them are simple. Similarly, injury attributed to petitioner Kashmir Singh with 'gandasi' on complainant Baljit Singh, is also stated to be a simple injury. The petitioners have been in custody for the last 4 to 5 months. It is a cross-version case wherein the cross case was registered at the instance of Malkiat Singh against Baljit Singh and others.

In view of said circumstances, petitioners Kashmir Singh, Gurnam Singh and Nishan Singh can be granted concession of bail as their case appears to be at par with Kuldeep Singh, Prem Singh and Surinder Singh who have been granted concession of regular bail.

Petition qua petitioner Bhola Singh is dismissed as withdrawn.

Petitions qua petitioners Kashmir Singh, Gurnam Singh and Nishan Singh are allowed. They are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
