The petitioner was not arrested along with any contraband but was booked in the case while he was in judicial custody in another case under the NDPS Act.

On the basis of recovery of Rs.15 lacs from his house, he has been involved in the case. Though no recovery was effected from him, he has been in custody w.e.f. 24.09.2015.

Learned State counsel has contended that the petitioner is involved in two other criminal cases.

Without expression of any opinion regarding his culpability in the other cases, it is sufficient to observe here that prima facie the basis of involvement in the present case will certainly be a debatable issue.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
