Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Manjit Singh @ Manna in case registered by way of FIR No.97 dated 26.08.2015 at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar under Sections 326/323/324/341/34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 12.04.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar who submits that the petitioner is no

longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.04.2016 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
