By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.40, dated 13.03.2016, registered under Section 18 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case. The alleged recovery of 295 grams of opium is a non commercial quantity. He further states that in pursuance of the order dated 12.04.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for

custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.04.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
