Main case

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal
Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect
the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents
No. 5 and 6.

2. Notice to respondents No. 1 to 4 only at this stage.

3. At the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

4. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Pathankot, Punjab to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated April 10, 2016 (Annexure P-5) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

5. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
