Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioners, namely, Sukhpal Singh @ Sukha and Raj Kumar @ Raju in case FIR No.68 dated 23.06.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Bahav Wala, District Fazilka.

There is alleged recovery of 110 bottles of Rexcof Syrup and 250 tablets of Carisoma.

Petitioners are stated to be in custody since 23.6.2015 and their application for grant of default bail under Section 167(2) Cr.PC is alleged to have been dismissed while illegally extending time to the prosecution to

submit the challan.

At the time of arguments, realising that the orders extending the time have not been challenged, learned Counsel for the petitioners pray for permission to withdraw the present petition to file fresh one with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
