ANITA CHAUDHRY, J (ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 57 dated 24.11.2014, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, Police Station Women, Bhatinda.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has been compromised and a petition for quashing of the present FIR on the basis of compromise, bearing No. CRM-M-2364-2016 has already been filed.

Vide order dated 6.1.2015 passed by this Court, arrest of the petitioner was stayed. Vide order of even date passed in CRM-M-14836-2015, the interim bail granted to the co-accused of the petitioner has been made absolute.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 6.1.2015 whereby

arrest of the petitioner was stayed is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
