Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.31 dated 14.3.2016, under Sections 307, 341, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa.

This Court vide orders dated 28.4.2016 and 4.8.2016, has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 4.8.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 28.4.2016.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Nachattar Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 28.4.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
