Kamaljeet Kaur wife of complainant Ravinder Sharma committed suicide. FIR in this regard was registered with the allegations that petitioner No. 1, Paramjeet Kaur, and her husband petitioner No. 2, Gurdeep Kumar Sharma, who are sister and brother-in-law respectively of the deceased have abetted the suicide of Kamaljeet Kaur by repeatedly taunting her and quarreling with her on her visits at parental home. As per the prosecution case, on 25.05.2015 when the deceased had gone to visit her parental home, petitioners quarrelled with her and sent her back by treating her badly as a result of which she committed suicide.

On the instructions of ASI Harnek Singh, it has been informed that petitioners have joined investigation. Perusal of the police file indicates that the complainant appears to have furnished an affidavit stating therein that he does not want to proceed against the petitioners.

Without expression of any opinion on the culpability of the petitioners, it appears debatable, in view of above circumstances, if the petitioners are responsible for the suicide committed by Kamaljeet Kaur.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 12.04.2016 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions that petitioners will join investigation, as and when required by the investigating agency and that will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the proceedings in any manner.
