Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered on the basis of secret information to the effect that Bhupinder Singh and others had constituted a gang and were planning to commit a dacoity and that they also indulge in smuggling of heroin, armed with deadly weapons. On raid having been conducted, all the accused were apprehended by the police with 2 kg of heroin and fire arms.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, he is neither named in the secret information/FIR nor was arrested from the spot. He was involved in this case on the basis of a disclosure statement made by co-accused Bhupinder Singh to the effect that the petitioner was also a member of the gang. With the said background, the petitioner has been in custody with effect from 21.12.2015.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, the petitioner can be granted concession of regular bail.

Petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
