By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.57, dated 22.03.2016, registered under Sections 420/406/506/120B of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), at Police Station Dhuri Sadar, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 12.04.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further states that the petitioner is neither owner nor he has got any concern with the agreement to sale purported to have been executed between Manpreet and Harnek Singh.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in

pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.4.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
