Prayer in this petition is for transfer of Criminal Case No.335 of 2015, titled as 'State Vs. Mandeep Singh', FIR No.64 dated 28.08.2012, under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station, Bhadson, District Patiala, from the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nabha to the competent Court at Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that some more cases are pending between the same parties at Amloh, which are detailed as under:-

- (i)“Complaint No.66 of 04.08.2012, titled as 'Kuldeep Kaur Vs. Mandip Singh', under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2015.
- (ii) Criminal Complaint No.4 of 14.03.2013, titled as 'Kuldeep Kaur Vs. Mandip Singh and others', under Sections 406/498-A/506/509/323 IPC.
- (iii) Criminal Misc. No.29 dated 15.11.2014 and CRM No.792 of 2014, titled as 'Kuldeep Kaur Vs. Mandip Singh and others' for seeking recovery of interim maintenance awarded by the Court.”

In the present case, challan has already been presented and,

thereafter, the accused has been declared as proclaimed offender on 06.08.2013.

Keeping in view that the aforesaid three criminal cases are pending at Amloh, this petition is allowed and Criminal Case No.335 of 2015, titled as 'State Vs. Mandeep Singh', FIR No.64 dated 28.08.2012, under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station, Bhadson, District Patiala, is withdrawn from the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nabha and is transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib. The entire record pertaining to the aforesaid case shall be sent by the trial Court at Nabha to the District & Sessions Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib, who will entrust it to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Amloh.
