By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in a compliant case registered under Sections 323, 427, 452, 120-B, 148 read with Section 149 IPC titled as Balinder and others Vs. Suraj Bhan and another, wherein the petitioners were ordered to be summoned under Sections 120-B, 148, 323, 427, 506 and 120 IPC.

On 12.04.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Having been summoned as accused in a private complaint, the petitioners apprehend arrest. Application filed by the petitioners before the Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal, has

been dismissed observing that the allegations are serious.

Notice to the respondents for 9.8.2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioners will put in appearance before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today. In case of petitioners doing so, they will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 12.04.2016, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.04.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
