JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass and interfere in their peaceful married life at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners Mr. Bharat Julka after obtaining order dated April 12, 2016, petitioners did not turn up to pursue the instant petition.

At this juncture, it has been submitted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Iqbal Singh, Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran that petitioners did not approach the police authorities for any security or police help. It appears that due to the registration of FIR No.49 dated 19.03.2016, under Sections 363, 366-A, petitioners are at large.

So in view of the facts and circumstances narrated above, there is nothing to proceed with the instant petition and as such, the same is dismissed at this stage.
