Learned counsel for the rival parties have been heard for quite some time. At the end of the hearing and after consultation with the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioners, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition for transfer of criminal case from the court of JMIC, Ludhiana. The allegations made by the petitioner are that as and when she used to visit Ludhiana Court, at least eight criminal cases have been got lodged at the instance of the respondent-husband out of which, in three cases, FIRs have been registered against her and some of the complaints were found to be false by the Ludhiana police.

In that view of the matter, the petitioner is permitted to file an application for protection with the trial court who shall sympathetically consider her application and if found necessary, direct the concerned police officer to extend protection to her and her family members.
