Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.70 dated 17.05.2009 under Sections 323, 324 and 341 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1). Prayer has also been made for quashing of order dated 04.03.2011 (Annexure P-2) whereby learned Magistrate has declared the petitioner as proclaimed offender.

The prayer qua quashing of FIR has already been withdrawn by the learned counsel for the petitioner while issuing notice of motion on 21.04.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 21.04.2016, petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and the trial Court has admitted him on bail.
