The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.16, dated 4.1.2016, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurgaon.

Allegations are that the petitioner was a witness to the sale deed in favour of the complainant but later on created a lease deed just to defeat the rights of the complainant. It is not disputed that civil litigation is also pending in regard to this dispute. The petitioner has joined the

investigation.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and the order dated 12.4.2016 is made absolute subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
