The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR  
No.14, dated 2.2.2016, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 471,  
120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Daba, Ludhiana.

It is not disputed that the petitioner has joined the  
investigation. Counsel for the petitioner states that no recovery is to be

made from the petitioner.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab and counsel for the complainant, however, assert that the petitioner has also got the share of ₹ 3.5 lacs out of the booty. Counsel for the petitioner states that this assertion is based only on the statement of the co-accused.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, this petition is allowed and the order dated 22.4.2016 is made absolute.
