This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.34 dated 24.01.2016 registered under Sections 406/420 IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Rohtak.

As per the allegations the petitioner has entered into agreement to sell a plot which she had already transferred in the name of her son.

The matter was adjourned on three occasions to enable the petitioner to try and settle the dispute. Today the learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite the fact that he has counseled the petitioner she is not willing to settle the dispute.

In the circumstances, I see no reason to continue the interim

protection granted by this Court.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
