This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.305 dated 15.9.2014 under sections 307, 341, 342, 186, 353, 332, 382, 427 I.P.C and section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Safidon, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, a police party had proceeded to the house of the present petitioner upon having received information that brother of the petitioner had entered into a love marriage with a girl and whose family was opposed of such matrimonial alliance. Allegations in a nutshell against the present petitioner are of being armed with a revolver and having assaulted the police party and having used derogatory language. Further specific allegation is with regard to the petitioner having inflicted a lathi blow on the head of ASI Parveen Kumar.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that even though the petitioner was stated to be armed with a revolver but there was no resort to firing. The injuries suffered by the police officials have

been opined to be simple in nature.

Petitioner has been in custody since 13.6.2015.

Learned State counsel would apprise the Court that in the trial that has ensued out of 20 prosecution witnesses 7 have been examined till date. The trial, as such, would take some time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merits and keeping in view the length of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Jind.

Petition disposed of.
