Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Anju Sharma in case FIR No. 294, dated 25.09.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 408 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Chandigarh.

As per the prosecution version, the petitioner was working as a Computer Operator-cum-Godown Incharge since February 2012 in M/s. G.V.D. Agencies having its office at S.C.O. No. 913, First Floor, N.A.C., Manimajra, Chandigarh, while its godown was at village Daria, Chandigarh. The petitioner committed fraud of Rs. 2.5 crores after wrongly entering the goods material as a scrap of which she was custodian, later on selling the same at half price and by keeping the said amount in her pocket.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by SI Bhim Sen, submits that the challan has been presented.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 24.11.2015.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
