Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide security to the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents as well as speedy action in FIR No.62 dated 11.4.2015 under Sections 295A/427/379/452/323/324/436/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already approached respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran by way of

representation dated 2.3.2016 (Annexure P-6), but no action thereon has been taken by the police so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the contents of application (Annexure P-6) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
