INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Gurjeet Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.218 dated 14.11.2014, registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 302 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. A. G. Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition. Police record has also been produced.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations, the

petitioner had murdered his wife, Mandeep Kaur. Some of the prosecution witnesses have already been examined.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is the main accused in the present case and there is every apprehension that he may tamper with the evidence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, as the petitioner is in custody since 15.06.2015, therefore, the Investigating Officer/Station House Officer of the concerned police station is directed to produce all the remaining prosecution witnesses for examination before the learned trial Court on the dates fixed, at the earliest.
