For having been found in possession of 80 grams of intoxicating powder containing diphenoxylate hydrochloride, the petitioner had been arrested on October 1, 2014. Petitioner was granted the concession of interim bail during the waiting period of report of Chemical Examiner. The interim bail granted to the petitioner was cancelled on November 19, 2015 on receipt of report of the Chemical Examiner.

In view of the quantity being commercial, I do not find any ground to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner. The petition is dismissed. Taking into consideration the fact that the interim bail granted to the petitioner has not been misused, he can be granted the concession of bail in case the prosecution agency fails to examine all the prosecution witnesses within a period of three months from the next date of hearing fixed before it. Ordered accordingly.
