Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that out of 19 witnesses cited in the case 13 have already been examined.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to raise all his pleas before the trial court at an appropriate stage. He further submits that personal appearance of petitioner No.2, who is a woman, may be exempted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

In case, petitioner No.2 moves an application for exemption of her personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petitioner No.2 on such terms and conditions as it deems proper to impose. Petitioner No.2 may be allowed to appear through her counsel except on the dates when her presence is necessary.
