JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

Instant petition has been preferred by Dharam Pal Singh Sidhu under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to official respondents to conduct fair investigation by some independent agency.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a complaint dated February 06, 2016 (Annexure P-1) was moved to Incharge, Police Post, Urban Estate, Phagwara but till date no action has been taken. He further contends that he feels satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to dispose of the said complaint within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to look into the grievances

unfolded by the petitioner in his complaint (Annexure P-1) moved to Incharge, Police Post, Urban Estate, Phagwara and in case some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
