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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to provide protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 5 and 6.

It has been averred that brother of the petitioner namely Lal Singh had married with respondent No.5 about 23 years back and he died on 10.08.2011. Thereafter, respondent No.5 had run away from the house with respondent No.6.

The grievance of the petitioners is that when the petitioners objected to the sanction of mutation of house constructed in 4 Biswas at village Sekhuwas, which was originally in the name of Lal Singh, brother of the petitioners, in favour of respondent No.5., respondents No.5 and 6 have started threatening the petitioners not to interfere in the mutation process.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have submitted a representation(Annexure P-1) in this regard to the police but no action

has been taken thereon. He submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into grievance of the petitioners only in relation to the threats received at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to have the grievance of the petitioners only in relation to the threats received at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6, looked into in accordance with law.
